Wilmslow Prep Scholars

Wilmslow Preparatory School once again celebrated a year of excellent results from their talented Form 6 pupils, including five scholarship offers.

This year's Form 6 recently sat exams for their chosen secondary schools and, as in previous years, the results were an astounding success. The 17 girls amassed 42 passes between them to some of the North West's top schools – including the five scholarship offers.

Holly Bennett (11) and Katie Hughes (11) received academic scholarships to Alderley Edge School for Girls and King's Macclesfield respectively, whilst Olivia Hamblyn (10) was awarded a music scholarship to King's Macclesfield. Robyn Copp-Barton (11) gained a music scholarship to King's Macclesfield and a joint music and sports scholarship to Manchester High.

Commenting on the offers, Headmaster Mr Paul Reynolds said: "We are all immensely proud of the girls' achievements, it is a real pleasure to see them all doing so well and we are delighted to have received five scholarship offers. School life is busy at Wilmslow Prep and it's worth noting that as well as studying hard these girls have also participated in many other activities including sport, drama, music and art as demonstrated by the three scholarships for music and sport.
