## Library Club

A new programme of extra-curricular activities has started this week. Library Club is highlighted here:



The Infant Department Library Club is run on Tuesdays from 3.30 pm to 4.15 pm. At Infant Library Club, we consider that reading for pleasure is a key element to a child's success as it can spark a child's creativity and imagination, transport them to far-off places full of adventure and excitement, while at the same time helping them make sense of their own world.

During their time in Library Club the children have the opportunity to listen to stories, develop their love for reading and engage in conversation to extend speech and language skills. The children also read individually and in small groups and undertake book reviews. They listen to audio books, engage in multimedia activities, read and write poetry and role play. The children are allowed to take a book home to read each week which is then discussed in Library Club the following week in order for the children to share their experiences.

## Puzzle Club



Puzzle Club is held every Friday lunchtime for children in Reception to F2. It is done on a rota basis so every child is given the opportunity to participate.

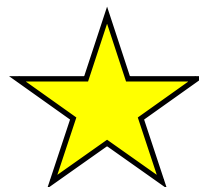
