In addition, School has also purchased a second defibrillator which is housed inside the Sports Hall.

Defibrillators are proven to save lives and are therefore an invaluable addition to the health and safety provision at WPS. All staff completed training in defibrillator use at the beginning of term.

Over the next six weeks we will be monitoring and recording the germination and growth rate of the seeds and comparing the results with those that had been left on Earth.
