Happy Birthday WPS 106 Years old!

On 23rd September 1909 Miss Mead & Miss Barber opened their new enterprise Wilmslow Preparatory School, a private academic establishment whose intention was to provide children with a sound, well rounded education that would prepare them for life and this is still our ethos 106 years later!

The School first opened above a butcher's shop on Grove Street with three pupils, two boys and 1 girl! Such was the popularity of Wilmslow Preparatory School that, within three years, it had outgrown the modest room above the butcher's shop and moved to a house in neighbouring Grove Avenue, a charming tree-lined road.

The School continued to grow and so Miss Mead and Miss Barber acquired the field across the road from the house, where they had a new purpose built school constructed in 1925. This is the building we still occupy today and, as the school has continued to grow and flourish, additional buildings housing more classrooms including a specialist art room, science room, music room, Modern Foreign Languages and Drama room, ICT suite and, of course, our fabulous Sports Hall built in 2007, providing outstanding all-weather sporting facilities for our wide and varied sport provision and programme of extra curricular activities, have been added.

It has become a tradition at WPS to celebrate the School Birthday every year, with each class making a special birthday card and everyone enjoying a slice of birthday cake!
