Healthy Eating

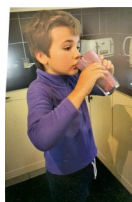
Our Healthy Eating topic across School draws to a close this week. It has been wonderful to see the children enjoying the topic, trying new foods and pledging to do more exercise with their families.
